

COUNTY CEMETERY

ADAIR COUNTY, MISSOURI

This cemetery is located on the south side of the Highland Park Cemetery, behind the Community Nursing Home (1979) at the east end of Normal Street in Kirksville. This home is owned by Adair County and was originally called the county farm. The county farm was originally next to the Cater Cemetery, and at that time burials were made in Cater. The oldest records at the home date back to 1881, for persons living at the county farm. However, records are not complete and in most cases the person is merely marked deceased and no burial place is designated. Many are buried in cemeteries with their families.

The information was gatered from the stones, from the Highland Park Secton, and from records at the home. It is believed there are several graves that are not known. Information was gathered by Elizabeth Laughlin and Frances Ames.
