Hamilton may also be known as old Wilson town. It is northeast a short way from Wilson town (first road east about 1/2 mile, then south through a pasture gate about 1/4 mile to a timbered area in the middle of a field. The cemetery is abandoned and is a mess of fallen trees and overgrowth. Many of the stones had fallen over and were covered with as much as 6 inches of dirt and leaf mold and were discovered by probing with a pitchfork. A bus load of students and their teacher from Brasher social science class probed, dug up and recorded the information from the stones with the help of Audrey Elmore and Elizabeth Laughlin. Mr. Elmore said the name Hamilton evolved because the Hamilton home was nearby.
