The Jewel Free Will Baptist Church is located about 4 miles Northwest of Kirksville on Route B on The 2 acres of land for the cemetery was given by Mr. & Mrs. A. M. Eggert. The church was named after the daughter of the first Mniste, Rev. & Mrs. Tom Ferguson.

The church was built in 1909. Everything for the new church was donated except the seats and a man charged for them when he made them.

James P. Potter, a war veteran was the first one buried there. No date is given. There are 9 known war veterans buried here.

My father, Mr. C. A. Findling, owned the farm later where the grave yard is taken from.

The cemetery was incorporated in 1976 with the following original officers elected: Donald Wayman, President; Jerry Findling, Vice-President; Mrs. Ora Talbert, Secretary; Mrs. Carl Otto, Treasurer; Rev. Archie Cooper, Board Member, Donnie Riley, Board Member.
