The Keller-Tuttle Cemetery on the Old Daniel Tuttle Farm.

Go On Highway 6 to Gibbs junction corner (Route V), turn north on gravel road, go about ½½ mile to where the road turns east. You turn west here through a farm gate into a field. The Cemetery is about ¾¾ mile mostly north and a little east, (a the crow flies), but about 2 miles to get around fenced areas in the southwest corner of a patch of timber. It is about 1 square acre in size, has a rundown barb wire fence and is over grown with bush and weeds, is abandoned.
