

# Novinger Family Cemetery

The information contained in "Novinger family Cemetery" should be changed to update and correct the original data. The burials here are all my family members and I, with some help, recently restored the entire area and stones discovering three previously unknown stones and some other information. I suggest the present write up be discarded and substitute the following:

Location: The cemetery is on the old Ira Novinger farm, formerly owned by John C., Hiram Novinger, Ira Novinger, Celia Novinger Hammons, and now by Celia's daughter Kay Hammons Crawford. The farm is adjacent to and immediately west of Novinger on Route O; the cemetery is located on the end of Pennyroyal Ridge, about 200 yards west of the Novinger city limits and 1/4 mile north of Route O. It is visible from Route O. The cemetery was established in 1871 and restored by concerned John C. Novinger descendants in 2001.
