

# SALISBURY-PARCEL CEMETERY

ADAIR COUNTY, MISSOURI

The Salisbury Cemetery is located on the bluff overlooking the Chariton River. It is reached by a private road three-tenths of a mile long leading from Adair County Route K to the cemetery. This junction is 1 ½ miles north of highway No. 11. This private road was given by Addie Murch and Hammond L. Murch, husband and wife, April 12, 1935. According to the older residents of the neighborhood the first person buried here was a slave. No one knows the exact date as no stone or record was made. The oldest stone was for William Parcels who died July 26, 1840. Other family names of the early settlers are Linder, Slover, Simler, Buress, Salisbury and Holman. Some have as many as five generations buried here. The land for the cemetery was given by early settlers of the neighborhood. The Parcels-Salisbury Cemetery Association was incorporated as a non-profit association November 8, 1971.

The name Salisbury is spelled three different ways on the markers in this cemetery, as follows: Salisbury, Salisberry, and Salsberry.
