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### Notes from the transcriber:

Hello! I had the pleasure of transcribing this Shumaker Cemetery for the Adair County Missouri web page,

I have not changed a letter or word from the original book, if you see a mistake in spelling or dates on any of the information listed below I transcribed this as it was in the book. There is also a map of the cemetery at the bottom of this page.

### SHUMAKER CEMETERY

Location, Adair County Mo. From the old Newburg Store on State Route 156 W, one mile north to the Macon- Adair County Line, west one fourth mile, north one -fourth mile to the first home: or can be reached from H-H off No.3.

### HISTORY OF SHUMAKER CEMETERY

This Cemetery had its Beginning in the early 1850's. It officially became the Shumaker Cemetery, December 16, 1880, when M.V Atteberry and wife, Margaret Atteberry, who owned the adjoining farmland at that time, deeded one-half acre of land to be used as a cemetery. The trustees appointed were Thomas Phillips, Henry Clem, and Henry Sewell.

In the extreme Northwest corner of the Plot is the isolated Grave (no 73 on the Chart) of a little boy who was claimed to be the first burial in this cemetery. He was said to have been traveling through the area with his family in a covered wagon, stopping at the home of acquaintances, whereupon was bitten by a rattlesnake causing his death. This story was told and claimed to be true by Nathaniel Phillips who was born and reared on a neighboring farm nearest the scene of this accident.

No 69 (on the chart) marks the grave of Muriel Shumaker, whose wife's name, Delores (Zimmerman) Shumaker, also appears on the stone, although she is still among the living (1979).

Any other interments in this cemetery are considered unlikely.

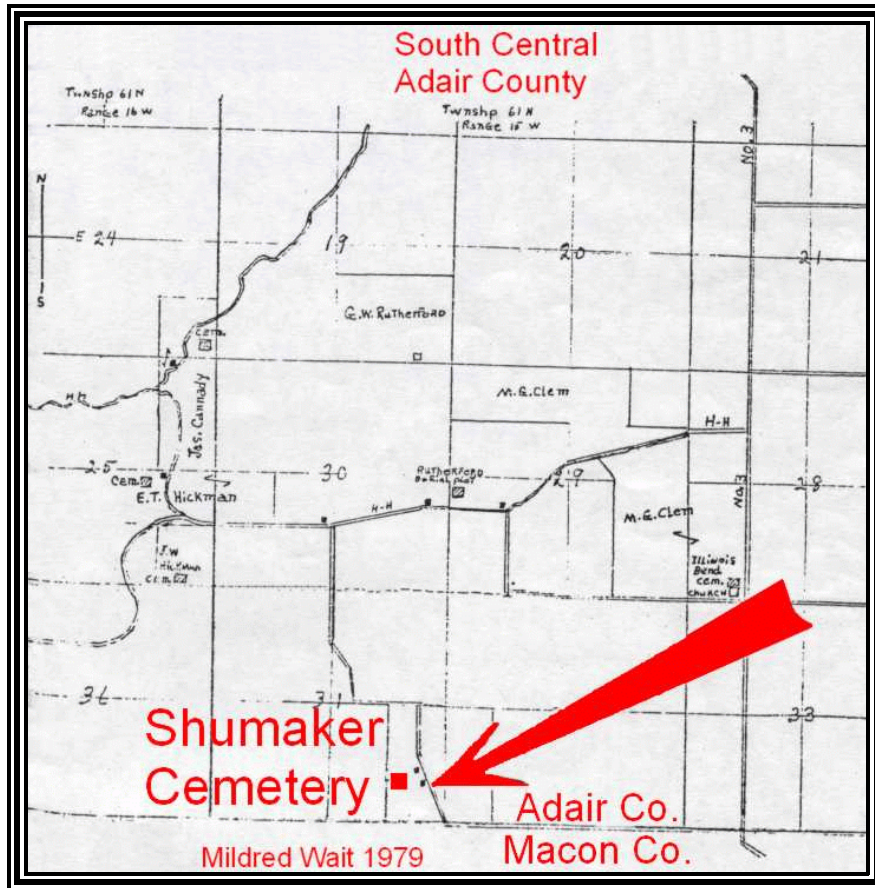

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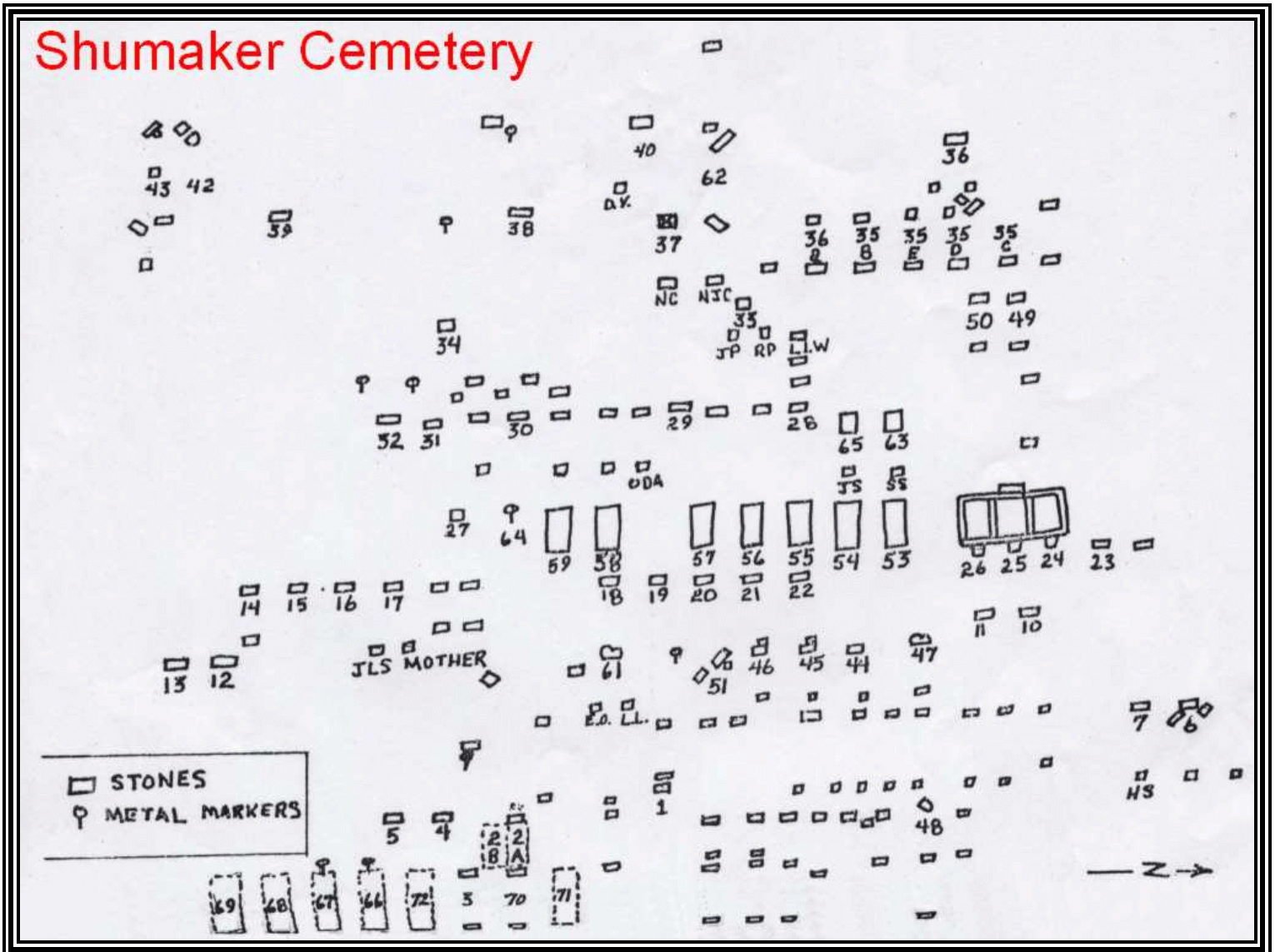
