

Sloan's Point CEMETERY

ADAIR COUNTY, MISSOURI

Very little is known of the origin of the Sloan's Point Cemetery, although some of the earliest settlers' of Adair County by the name of Sloan came here from Kentucky in 1840. The little town of Sloan nestled in the curve of the Chariton River about six miles west of Kirksville and the cemetery is located on a bluff across and east of the river.

A one-room log schoolhouse was built near the cemetery and was later torn down and a larger schoolhouse built. Arthur Young, grandson of George Young, who founded Youngstown, remembers that when there was a funeral, school was dismissed and the services were held in this building. In the early 1900's, this building was torn down and a new school was built on one acre of land south of the cemetery donated by George Young. Thus, enlarging the cemetery to the size it is today.

The earliest graves are located in the north west part of the cemetery and although the later graves are in a line, there seems to be no organized plot.

Today the cemetery is supported by Perpetual Care and the Association has the following officers: Gary Luman President, Marvice Mears Vice President, Irene Luman Secretary and Lila M. Farr Treasurer.

Directions to Sloan's Point Cemetery: Adair County, Missouri

From Kirksville, go south to Hwy. 11 and turn west. Continue on Hwy. 11 until it makes a slight bend in the road. Leave Hwy. 11 and continue straight onto the gravel road. Follow gravel road turning right at the first intersection. Continue on this road. This is known as the road back of Forrest Lake. The cemetery sits on the hill on the left side of the road.
