

# WILSONTOWN CEMETERY

(also known as New Wilson)

## ADAIR COUNTY, MISSOURI

According to the records on March 4, 1872, a tract of land was sold by William R. Kirkpatrick and his wife, Sarah A. Kirkpatrick, to Samuel P. Barnhart, James Rice, James T. Cline, and James N. Folkeman (?). These men were trustees of the United Brethren in Christ Church of Wilson. The land is described as: beginning at the N. E. corner of section 30 in township 61, range 13 running west 40 rods, thence south 10 rods, thence east 40 rods, thence north 10 rods to the place of beginning with the reserve of 2 rods on the north side of one rod on the east side for public highway.

This land was sold to the above named men as a board of trustees or their successors of the church named, to have and to hold, and was to be controlled by them, but was to be "free to all Christian denominations to preach and to worship there-in".

Sometime between the years of 1872 and 1895 the building began to be used by the Baptists as a place of worship. It is not clear when the first church was built. As the story was handed down, in those days a popular form of entertainment was debating, and the church was used for this purpose. During a particularly interesting debate, with a large crowd present, the floor of the building gave way. The people were so interested in the discussion they rushed to their buggies and wagons and went to another building (a church or schoolhouse) probably two miles distant and continued their debate. It would be interesting to know the subject being debated and the debaters, but unfortunately this is not known.

The church building apparently was beyond repair or required extensive repairs, and at this time the United Brethren congregation decided to sell to the Baptists. On July 22, 1895 the trustees of the United Brethren in Christ then were W. C. Tuttle, J. F. Darnell, and Moses Starr. They sold the original tract of land to the trustees of the Northfork Baptist Church,

namely John Chadwell, James R. Pemberton and O. W. Clotfelter for the sum of \$100.00. The Baptist trustees and/or their successors were to have full control of said property, including the building. The cemetery had evidently been laid out and used by both denominations for on August 22, 1895, only one month after the Baptists had obtained the parcel of land that included what is now the cemetery and what was the church yard the following transaction is on record:

James Chadwell, James R. Penberton, and O. W. Clotfelter, acting as agents of the Northfork Baptist church, sold a parcel of land described as beginning at the NE. Corner of section 30, Township 61, range 13, running west 32 rods, thence south 10 rods, thence east 32 rods, thence north 10 rods to point of beginning containing 2 acres more or less to Chester Woods, A. Barnhart, S. C. Davidson, Robert E. Thompson, and O. C. Barrows, acting as trustees for the public, to be used "exclusively as a burying ground for all the vicinity to bury their dead upon". The sum of \$1.00 was paid for this. The remainder of the original 40 rods by 10 rods tract was to be held by the church for church purposes.

As the story was handed down this was a public burying ground, and no one was to be charged for a lot there. The cemetery has been laid out in lots, but over the years the record has not been kept up to date, walk ways and drives ways have been used for grave spaces so the plat is not accurate. The cemetery was allowed to grow up in weeds and grass. In 1959 a sum of money was raised and has been added to from time to time, and the cemetery has become more presentable. At the present time we would like to see our investment fund increased so the interest from it would enable us to do more than merely keep the weeds and grass mowed. This has, however, helped the appearance of the cemetery greatly, and we are quite proud of that accomplishment. Due to the declining farm population in the vicinity the church building was torn down in 1970, and the money from the sale of the building and furnishings was given to the cemetery. At this time we hesitate to say we have perpetual care, but we have been able to carry on with the mowing for 20 years.

When the program of keeping the cemetery started in 1959, the Star Christian Church building, which had not been used for worship purposes for many years, was sold and this money given to the cemetery association to be used in helping with the upkeep. The Star Church was located a short distance south and east of the Wilsontown Cemetery and church. Since the cemetery was to be used as a "public burying ground" all living in the vicinity were interested in keeping the grounds in a presentable condition.
